- We asked for it to be during the school day and in small groups. Do a half hour and create something, have muffins or some snack. Still waiting to hear more on it.
 - Maybe do it on a Sunday after 10am Mass.
- End of Year Events!
 - Field Day & Hot Dog Lunch June 12th Chair: Tracy Hadden(Field Day) & Angel Panowicz (Hot Dog Lunch)
 - Field Day is about \$1000, Hot dog cookout is about \$1000
 - We don't know too many details because it is during the school day.
 - o End of Year Party/Color Run/Adult Cornhole June 15th
 - Incorporate color run, just for fun, no cost. Have 2 start times, kids wear white. They run the triangle and we throw the colored packets at them.
 - Administration is open to the idea of working with Apex. Doing a color run or dance party (glow party, silent disco, etc). We asked for dates to be picked now for the 2023-2024 school year.
 - They do character building activities with the kids. Need about a 2 week block, but they aren't in the building for the entire two weeks.
 - Year end gift for faculty, \$100 each. Milestone and retirement also receive a monetary gift.
- Financial Report Jen Baer, Treasurer- \$23,487.84
- School Supply Fundraiser Mary Kate Conrad
 - This is just an idea. They put together the kits with all school supplies and deliver them to the school directly. Parents can order online. All name brand items.
 - Can be a fundraiser also by tacking a few extra dollars onto the kits.
 - We would have to sign a commitment form.
 - Have an option for a box to send for entire classroom (like glue sticks or pencils)
- Board of Trustees Meeting
 - Kristen and Mary Kate went to present about what is going on in the school and voice concerns.
 - Asked where the board gets their scope of what is going on in the school and suggested doing a survey. It seems they are going to do it because it's overdue. Last time one was done was more directed to a COVID time.
 - **Parent:** There is not much information on the Board of Trustees. What is their role in our school and can we have information on who they are and what their purpose is?
- Spring STREAM Update
 - Waiting on sign-up so kids can do the competition in May at St. Joe's.
 - If there is a lack of teachers, we are looking to parents to help fill in and run the STREAM clubs.
 - o Parent: I thought STREAM was coming back in February?
- Parent Concerns

- Calendar needs to be updated with more details.
 - Heads up about dress down days, not an email 1-2 days before.
 - Include all events. (HSA events, concerts, dress down days)
- Offer music lessons -Paul (last name?) want to look into the program that other schools use.
- Looking into Mt. St. Mary Auditorium (or any catholic high school) for our concerts. Look into the cost.
- Have the Athletic Director send all the upcoming dates to Kelly Gotham-Audin so we can get it all posted on social media.
- Do we know the protocol for the lockdown drills?
 - It is set by the Town of Tonawanda Police and all schools in the Ken-Ton area follow it. All schools public and non-public are treated equally with TOT security (visits/interactions with schools).
 - Parents have expressed concerns about the safety of doors and windows of the school. Mary Kate and Kristen explained that this was being addressed by Admin and the parish.
 - **Parent**: This type of information should be communicated to the parents so that we are aware that the security of the building is being addressed.
 - Concern about too many entrances, ex: 3rd-8th grade door on the back. There isn't always a teacher there in the morning. Have a single point of entry.
- Have 8th grade safety patrol to prevent people using the parking lot at the end of day.
 - Katie Fisher has access to high visibility vests.
 - Parents expressed concerns that they still see parents/grandparents picking-up in the parking lot.
- Field Trips?
 - Parent asked if there was information on field trips. Other parents stated that they had information from their child's teacher. Direction was given to parents if they haven't heard about your grade field trips, contact your teachers.
 - **Parent:** All we want is advance notice especially since field trips are submitted prior to Christmas.
 - **Parent:** Parents work, and need to request time off. Advanced notice is required.
- Volunteer compensation
 - Can we offer something to increase volunteer participation?
 - <u>Example</u>: Parent chairs an event, knock off \$50 from BEST account balance.
 - <u>Example</u>: Tuition incentive. Sell football tickets and then whoever sells the most is entered into a raffle to get half off tuition.

- Welcome Crew
 - Looking to assemble this committee for welcome back events (ice cream social, supply drop off)

• Gym T-shirts

- There is a large t-shirt bill (increase in price due to fabric of shirt and quantity ordered) that needs to be paid. The bill was for 520 t-shirts. We have 300-350 kids at the school.
 - Propose to pay for the number of t-shirts that equal the number of children that were enrolled as of September.
 - Parents that are present support this proposal.
- o Future suggestions
 - Option 1: Pause purchasing shirts for everyone. Hoping to offer a coupon at supply drop off towards the Fall apparel order.
 - Option 2: Children will receive shirts when HSA family dues are paid.
 - Option 3: Receive coupon when HSA family dues are paid.
